Core value:

Therefore, Refuge Children Home values children as the foundation for family, church, community and nation.

Mission Statement:

Refuge Children Home exists to provide an educational platform, physical shelter for daily basic needs, and specific church care in a family environment where they can develop their relationship with God.

Vision statement:

We envision that the children will be developed intellectually with true knowledge, spiritually in close relationship with God, socially by manifesting the fruits of Christian characters. Being developed as a mature disciple of Christ they will be leading different professions by influencing people through the love of Christ, where their lives themselves will be the model of the gospel.

Introduction (Background):

A homeless kid who had been abused was expelled from a hotel in Siliguri India while travelling from Bhutan. So, my spouse Ganga Tamang was thrilled with the compassion to this poor kid again being re-homeless. As we were in Nepal in 2015 we saw homeless and parentless kids begging for food and shelter, so after the greatest disasters (Earthquakes) we thought and began with the 40 days fasting and prayer ministry to separate our food and fabrics for these poorest of poor orphans.

Well, when I was driving from New Port News VA. Right after the church visitation, during the hot summer in Sept. 2014 I was very much thirsty but never drank a bottle of water as I saw the kids crying and jumping seeking food in the water bottle. So, we prayerfully began helping these orphans with not only food and shelter but also with quality education and health care too.

Our Planning

1 From Rental to own residential house:

This is our first and major concern that we want to be free from monthly rental payment. When we will have our own buildings, our huge financial resources will be saved and it makes our financial burden lighter. We plan following buildings for our home.



2. Local Resources:

In future, Refuge children home will be run by its own local resources. We want this ministry to be continues as long as God want and our vision be achieved. Therefore we want to handover this ministry to the next generation with solid financial foundation. Following are the long term plan for financial resources:

- (a) Poultry Farm
- (b) Husbandry
- (c) Agriculture

3. Material Facilities for Children:

We have passion to serve children with all the Excellency that we can provide for them. As a result, they may be able to compete with the rapidly developing world. We have plan to provide these facilities for their improvement of life.

- (a) Technology: Computer system education
- (b) Skill Development: There will be extra skill development activities such as music, electronic, arts etc. Along with education student can be involved in any one sector as their capacity and interest.
- (c) Plan to provide enough sport facility so that the children will be healthy and smart. Some of them make their carrier upon it.

4. Educational Planning:

We want complete future of child. In Nepal context, self-supporting stage is not as it is in western context. We have seen many students are supported up to S.L.C. or +2 after that he /she is left. Only few are able to catch up to carrier but most of other students are not able to continue their further education carrier. Therefore we design our plan up to master level by following:

- Class 1 to +2 students receives full scholarship both residential and schooling.
- Bachelor Level student will earn for their living but their education will be supported by Everest Children Home.
- Master Level student will be fully dependent upon themselves for their encouragement and help, we provide them half scholarship.

5. Children Church:

We plan for children church where children up to age 16 will be attended. They will feel free, learn with excitement and enjoy the blessed fellowship with different activities in week. They will be taught discipleship in the way they can learn.

Financial Policy:
